



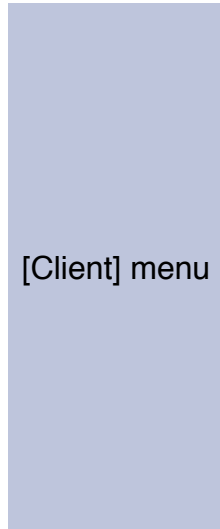

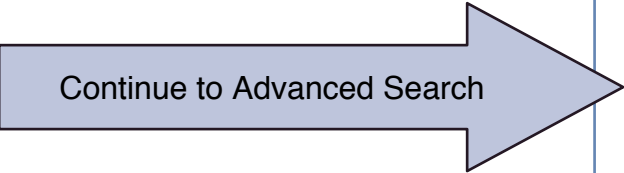

1 Once at the [Client] Homepage, Peggy decides to use the search box to locate information about coronary artery disease.

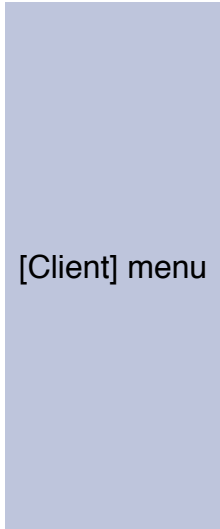
2 As a new user to the site, Peggy enters the words "Coronary Artery Disease" in the search box and presses "GO".
